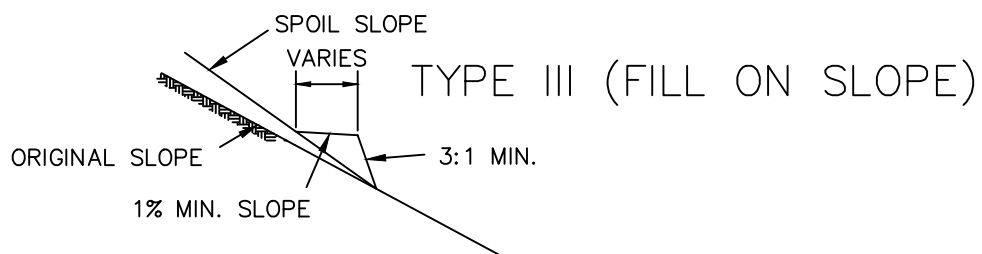
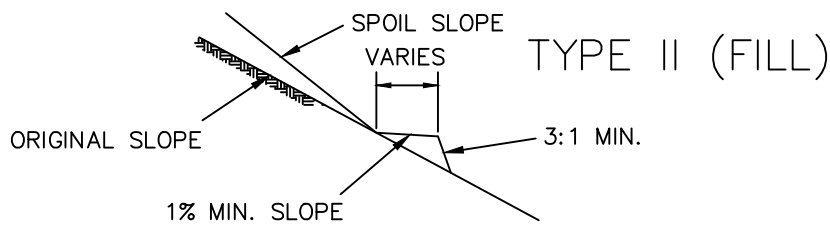
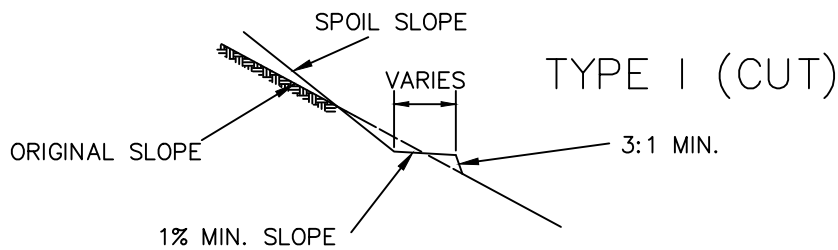
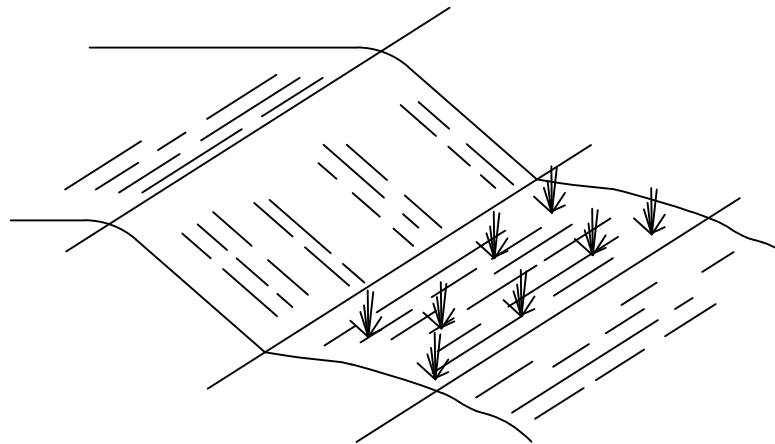


A VEGETATED STRIP AT THE TOE OF A SLOPE TO REDUCE RUNOFF VELOCITY AND ALLOW SEDIMENT TO DEPOSIT



- CONSTRUCT AS SOON AS THE TOE OF THE SLOPE IS ESTABLISHED
- BUILD ONLY WHERE RUNOFF IS FROM FILL SLOPES
- 10' WIDE/100' SLOPE LENGTH
- OUTER SLOPES OF BERM 3:1 OR FLATTER
- COMPACT SOIL AND VEGETATE $\geq 10'$ UP SLOPE
- SLOPE 1% TO 3% AWAY FROM TOE OF SLOPE
